

the undersigned, JOE A. FULLER, Registered Professional Land Surveyor, do hareby; certify, that the following field notes represent a survey made on the ground of the following described tract or parcel of land situated in Walker County, Texas:

Being 0.361 acre of land, more or less, situated in the Citycol Muntsville, P. GRAY SURVEY, Abstract No. 24, Walker County, Texas and being the same tract or parcel of land as described in a Deed from Murray A. Brown to James A. Jarboe, IV, dated November 19, 1987, and recorded in Volume 59, Page 325, Official Records, said 0.361 acre tract being more definitely described as follows:

peginning at the northeast corner of said Jarboe tract, same being the most easterly southeast corner of a called 0.254 acre tract as described in a Deed from the Texas Commerce Bank National Association, Trustee to Thomas A. Leeper, dated August 30, 1995, and recorded in Volume 261, Page 700, Official Records, and also being the called west line of "Avenue N-1/2", found a 3" concrete monument with cap.

THENCE suc. 17'40"B, with the east line of said Jarboe tract and the called west line of said road, for a distance of 120.66 feet to the southeast corner of said Jarboe tract, same being the apparent intersection of the called west line of said Avenue N-1/2 with the called north line of "20th Street", found a 5/8" iron rod;

THENCE 887°47'10"W, with the south line of said Jarboe tract, and the called north line of said 20th Street, for a distance of 144.35 fact to the southwest corner of said Jarboe tract, same being the southeast corner of an Access Rasement as described in "Tract B" in al Deed recorded in Volume 253, Page 511. Official Records, found a broken concrete monument;

THENCE NO9°39'20"B, with the west line of said Jarbos tract and the east line of said Access Essement, for a distance of 64.30 feet to an angle point, set a 5/8" iron rod;

THENCE N20.47.36"E, with the west line of said Jarboe tract and the east line of said Access Basement, for a distance of 36.00 feet to an angle point in the west line of said Jarboe tract, same being the most easterly northeast corner of said Access Basement, and also being the most southerly southwest corner of said Leeper tract, found a 3" concrete monument with cap;

THENCE N36\*55'46"B, with a northwest line of said Jarboe tract, and a southeast line of said Leeper tract, for a distance of 27.55 feet to an angle point, found a 3" concrete monument with cap)

THENCE N74\*18'29"E, continuing with a north line of said Jarboe tract, and a south line of said Leeper tract, for a distance of 22.45 feet to another angle point, found a 3" concrete monument with a cap?

THENCE N89\*14'01"E, continuing with the north line of said Jarboe tract and the south line of said Leeper tract, for a distance of \$1.89 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING.
