E-1 was dispatched to 519 Mallie for a fire call. The call was upgraded to building fire and deputy 1 advised alarm to upgrade the response to a box alarm. Deputy 1, BC1, L1, E3, E4 and M43 were dispatched.

E1 arrived on location with smoke showing from a single story residence. E1 made a fast attack. DC1 and BC1 arrived on location. DC1 established command and assigned BC1 to Division A. DIV A advised fire from the attic.

L1 arrived on location and was assigned to primary search. L1 E/O assisted E1 E/O with water supply and utilities. E2 arrived on location and was assigned to assist E1. E3 arrived on location and was assigned RIC.

M43, D1 and M26 arrived on location and were assigned to medical branch.

#1, 101, 111, 112, 113, 114, and 115 arrived on location.

Date Printed 2-1-24

Primary search was completed and the fire was extinguished. E2 completed a secondary search.

E3, D1 and M26 were released by command. Air monitoring .5 HCN 0 CO Overhaul was completed.

The power and gas companies arrived on location. The Red Cross was notified and advised that they would contact the displaced occupants. E2 was released.

Command was terminated and BC1 and DC1 returned to service.

E1 and L1 cleared the scene. 112 remained on location.
