- D. Order in which funds are applied. A tenant who in bad faith violates this section is liable to the landlord for an amount equal to three times the rent wrongfully withheld and the landlord's reasonable attorney's fees in a suit to recover the rent."
- B. Sec. 92.104 of the Texas Property Code states "Before returning a security deposit, the landlord may deduct from the deposit damages and charges for which the tenant is legally liable under the lease or as a result of breaching the lease. The landlord may not retain any portion of a security deposit to cover normal wear and tear. If the landlord retains all or part of a security deposit under this section, the landlord shall give to the tenant the balance of the security deposit, if any, together with a written description and itemized list of all deductions. The landlord is not required to give the tenant a description and itemized list of deductions if:
  - (1) the tenant owes rent when he surrenders possession of the premises; and
  - (2) there is no controversy concerning the amount of rent owed.

- 8. **ALTERATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS**. Tenant(s) shall make no alterations to the buildings or improvements on the Premises or construct any building or make any other improvements on the Premises without the prior written consent of Landlord. Any and all alterations, changes, and/or improvements built, constructed or placed on the Premises by Tenant(s) shall, unless otherwise provided by written agreement between Landlord and Tenant(s), be and become the property of Landlord and remain on the Premises at the expiration or earlier termination of this Texas Lease Agreement.
- 9. **LIABILITY**: Landlord is not responsible to Tenant(s) or guests for injuries, damages to person or property caused by natural elements, theft, vandalism, or environmental contaminants, unless caused by Landlord.
- 10. **NON-DELIVERY OF POSSESSION**. In the event possession cannot be delivered within such time, through no fault of Landlord or its agents, then this Texas Lease Agreement and all rights hereunder shall terminate.
- 11. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS. Tenant(s) shall not keep on the Premises any item of a dangerous, flammable or explosive character that might unreasonably increase the danger of fire or explosion on the Premises or that might be considered hazardous or extra hazardous by any responsible insurance company.
- 12. **UTILITIES**. Tenant(s) shall be responsible for arranging for and paying for all utility services required on the Premises.
- 13. **RENTERS INSURANCE**. Landlord requires Tenant(s) to obtain renters insurance for the duration of the Texas Lease Agreement.

- Replace all light bulbs and batteries for smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, and garage door openers;
- K. Replace misplaced keys;
- L. Secure exterior faucets during freezing weather;
- M. Know how to shut-off the main water valve and switch breakers off at appropriate times;

Tenant(s) shall not permit any animal, including mammals, reptiles, birds, fish, rodents, or insects on the property, even temporarily, unless otherwise agreed by a separate written Pet Agreement. If Tenant(s) violates the pet restrictions of this Lease, Tenant(s) will pay to Landlord a fee of \$50.00 per day per animal for each day Tenant(s) violates the animal restrictions as additional rent for any unauthorized animal. Landlord may remove or cause to be removed any unauthorized animal and deliver it to appropriate local authorities by providing at least 24-hour written notice to Tenant(s) of Landlord's intention to remove the unauthorized animal. Landlord will not be liable for any harm, injury, death, or sickness to any unauthorized animal. Tenant(s) is responsible and liable for any damage or required cleaning to the Property caused by any unauthorized animal and for all costs Landlord may incur in removing or causing any unauthorized animal to be removed.
- 23. **SMOKING.** Smoking is not permitted inside the property. If Tenant(s) violates the smoking restrictions of this Lease, the Landlord may deduct from the security deposit damages caused by smoking.
- 24. **WATERBEDS**. THERE WILL BE NO WATERBEDS, unless authorized by a separate written Waterbed Addendum to this Residential Lease Agreement.
- 25. **QUIET ENJOYMENT.** Tenant(s), upon payment of all of the sums referred to herein as being payable by Tenant(s) and Tenant(s)'s performance of all Tenant(s)'s agreements contained herein and Tenant(s)'s observance of all rules and regulations, shall and may peacefully and quietly have, hold and enjoy said Premises for the term hereof in accordance with the College Station Noise Ordinance.
- 26. **INDEMNIFICATION**. If Landlord's right of reentry is exercised following abandonment of the Premises by Tenant(s), then Landlord shall consider any personal property belonging to Tenant(s) and left on the Premises to also have been abandoned, in which case Landlord may dispose of all such personal property in any manner Landlord shall deem proper and Landlord is hereby relieved of all liability for doing so.

- 33. **BINDING EFFECT**. The covenants, obligations and conditions herein contained shall be binding on and inure to the benefit of the heirs, legal representatives, and assigns of the parties hereto.

- 7. Tenants agree to keep their pet(s) from being unnecessarily noisy or aggressive and causing any annoyance or discomfort to others and will remedy immediately any complaints made through the Landlord or Manager.
- 8. Tenants agree to provide their pet(s) with regular health care, to include inoculations as recommended.
- 9. Tenants agree to provide their pet(s) with an identification tag.
- 10. Tenants agree to get rid of their pet(s)' offspring within eight weeks of birth.

- 11. Tenants agree to pay immediately for any damage, loss, or expense caused by their pet(s), and in addition, they will add \$600.00 to their security deposit, any of which may be used for cleaning, repairs or delinquent rent when Tenant(s) vacate. This added deposit, or what remains of it when pet damages have been assessed, will be returned to Tenant(s) within 30 days after they have proved that they no longer keep this pet(s).
- 12. Tenants agree that this Agreement applies only to the specific pet(s) described above and that no other pet(s) may be substituted.
- 13. Tenants agree to furnish the Landlord with a picture of their pet.
- 14. Tenants agree that the Landlord reserves the right to revoke permission to keep the pet(s) should the Tenants break this agreement.
