

A Designates **<u>Pedestrian Only</u>** Access

B Designates <u>Boat Launch</u> & <u>Pedestrian</u> Access GUIDELINES\*

- Property owners who live on the inland lakes have boat access from their own property. Others may put trailered boats in Horseshoe, West and Westwood Lakes at locations designated on this map by B.
- 2. Non-motorized watercraft and fishing boats with electric motors are permitted on the inland lakes. Gasoline motors of five-horsepower or less are permitted on Westwood Lake only.
- 3. Boats shall at all times be used in a safe and prudent manner.
- 4. Pedestrian traffic only on all dams. No vehicles of any kind allowed. No golf carts allowed.
- 5. No Parking on the entrance road from 356.

6. No trot or throw lines.

- 7. Access is not allowed on banks in front of a property owner's home or lot, without permission of the property owner. Do not play loud music, walk on people's property or leave trash behind.
- 8. When fishing or boating on inland lakes, respect both the environment and neighbors.
