


The Pelican Nest Bed and Breakfast

Step back in time as you enter this charming Texas Gulf Coast residence steeped in local history.

The back-living area of the home beyond the French doors is one of the original homes in this area built by the Palms family. The Palms brothers settled in Clear Lake from New Orleans in 1879, choosing this area because they felt Clear Lake and not Galveston would be the future port of the gulf. The brothers had cypress wood milled in Louisiana then boated in, building the first General Store and Post Office on Clear Lake Rd as well as a business providing rental transportation to those who would disembark at the Seabrook Tran Station traveling to the bay side resorts.

In the early 1900's Mr. Palms built two houses for the family near the railroad tracks behind the General Store. This smaller residence, and a larger Victorian residence that burnt down in 1980.

In 1980 Mr. Frank Jureczki purchased the lot these residences were on and built Franks Shrimp Hut, which is now Hooters (146 and NASA Rd). The intent was to tear the smaller residence down, nevertheless, found that it was in good condition and in 1984 had it relocated to 1228 First St, Seabrook, 77586. Mr. Jurecski expanded the property adding the front area of the home, the upstairs, and wrap around deck. The back door at the end of the hallway was originally the front door, while the front porch is now being used as the sunroom. The *Bay Breeze* room with the bay window was the original living room.

The Jurecski family enjoyed the home for several years and share special family memories here in Seabrook
