The total amounts of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes, excluding refunding bonds that are separately approved by the voters are: \$0.00 for water, sewer, drainage, and storm sewer facilities. The aggregate initial principal amounts of all such bonds issues are: \$237,000 for water, sewer, drainage, and storm sewer facilities.

The District is located wholly or partly within the corporate boundaries of the City of Hitchcock, Texas. The municipality and the District overlap, but may not provide duplicate services or improvements. Property located in the municipality and the District is subject to taxation by the

Municipality and the District. The purpose of the District is to provide water, sewer, drainage, or flood control facilities and services. The cost of district facilities is not included in the purchase price of your property. Texas laws govern the ability of a municipality to annex property in the municipality and whether a district that is annexed by the municipality is dissolved.


