In compliance with Section 49.455, Texas Water Code, as amended, the undersigned members of the Board of Directors of Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 36 (the "District") hereby affirm as of the date hereinafter set out that the following information is correct and accurate:

- 1. The name of the District is Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 36.
- 2. The most recent rate of taxes established by the District on property located in the District is set forth in the form of Notice to Purchasers contained in <u>Exhibit "A"</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes, as same may hereafter be from time to time amended.
- 3. The total amount of bonds that have been approved by the voters and which may be issued by the District (excluding refunding bonds and any bonds or portion of bonds payable solely from revenues received or expected to be received pursuant to a contract with a governmental entity) is \$34,500,000.00.
- 4. The aggregate initial principal amount of all bonds of the District payable in whole or in part from taxes (excluding refunding bonds and any bonds or portion of bonds payable solely from revenues received or expected to be received pursuant to a contract with a governmental entity) that have been previously issued is \$30,885,000.00
- 5. If a standby fee is imposed by the District, the amount of the standby fee is set forth in the form of Notice to Purchasers contained in <u>Exhibit "A"</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes, as same may hereafter be from time to time amended.
- 6. The date on which the election to confirm the creation of the District was held is January 6, 1943.
  - 7. The functions performed or to be performed by the District are as follows:
    - (a) Supply water for municipal uses, domestic uses, power, and commercial purposes and all other beneficial uses or controls;
    - (b) Collect, transport, process, dispose of, and control all domestic, industrial, or communal wastes, whether in fluid, solid, or composite state;
    - (c) Gather, conduct, divert, and control local storm water or other local harmful excesses of water in the District;
    - (d) Irrigate the land in the District;
    - (e) Alter land elevation in the District where it is needed;
    - (f) Navigate coastal and inland waters of the District; and
    - (g) Provide parks and recreational facilities for the inhabitants in the District.

We, the undersigned, being the duly chosen members of Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 36, each for himself, affirm and declare that the above is true and correct to the best of our knowledge and belief.



## NOTICE TO PURCHASER OF SPECIAL TAXING OR ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

STATE OF TEXAS §

The real property that you are about to purchase is located in the HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 36 (the "District") and may be subject to district taxes or assessments. The district may, subject to voter approval, impose taxes and issue bonds. The district may impose an unlimited rate of tax in payment of such bonds. The current rate of the District property tax is \$0.2383 on each \$100 of assessed valuation for debt service purposes. The total amounts of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes, excluding refunding bonds that are separately approved by the voters, approved by the voters are:

\$ 34,500,000.00 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities.

The aggregate initial principal of all such bonds issues are:

\$ 30,885,000.00 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities.

The District has the authority to adopt and impose a standby fee on property in the District that has water, sanitary sewer, or drainage facilities and services available but not connected and which does not have a house, building, or other improvement located thereon and does not substantially utilize the utility capacity available to the property. An unpaid standby fee is the personal obligation of the person that owned the property at the time of imposition and is secured by a lien on the property. Any person may request a certificate from the District stating the amount, if any, of unpaid standby fees on a tract of property in the district.

The District is located wholly in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Houston. Texas law governs the ability of a municipality to annex property in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction and whether a district that is annexed by the municipality is dissolved. The District has entered into a strategic partnership agreement with the City of Houston. This agreement may address the timeframe, process, and procedures for the municipal annexation of the area of the District located in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

The purpose of the District is to provide water, sanitary sewer service, storm sewer drainage, irrigation, solid waste collection and disposal, including recycling, and to construct parks and recreational facilities services. The cost of district facilities is not included in the purchase price of your property.
