Pursuant to V.T.C.A., Texas Water Code, Section 49.452 and 49.455 as amended, the Board of Directors of Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 96 (the "District") now gives the following notice to all sellers and purchasers of real estate situated within the boundaries of said District and requests that you refer to its original Amended and Restated Notice to Sellers and Purchasers of Real Estate Situated in Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 96, dated November 3, 2009 and recorded in Clerk's File Number 20090502245 of the Real Property Records of Harris County, Texas.

The only modifications and updates to the Notice are in regards to Items 3 and 9, which now should read as follows:

- 3. The most recent rate of District taxes on property located in the District is \$0.68 per \$100 assessed valuation.
 - 9. The form of the Notice to Purchasers is as follows:

NOTICE TO PURCHASER OF SPECIAL TAXING OR ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

The real property that you are about to purchase is located in the Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 96 (the "District") and may be subject to District taxes or assessments. The District may, subject to voter approval, impose taxes and issue bonds. The District may impose an unlimited rate of tax in payment of such bonds. The current rate of the District property tax is \$0.68 on each \$100 of assessed valuation. The total amounts of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes, excluding refunding bonds that are separately approved by the voters and excluding any bonds or any portions of bonds issued that are payable solely from revenues received or expected to be received under a contract with a governmental entity, approved by the voters are:

- (i) \$88,000,000 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities; and
- (ii) \$8,000,000 for parks and recreational facilities.

The aggregate initial principal amounts of all such bonds issued are:

- (i) \$62,480,000 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities; and
- (ii) \$5,315,000 for parks and recreational facilities.

The District sought and obtained approval of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to adopt and impose a standby fee. The amount of the standby fee is \$0.00. An unpaid standby fee is a personal obligation of the person that owned the property at the time of imposition and is secured by a lien on the property. Any person may request a certificate from the District stating the amount, if any, of unpaid standby fees on a tract of property in the District.

The District is located wholly or partly in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Houston. Texas law governs the ability of a municipality to annex property in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction and whether a district that is annexed by the municipality is dissolved.

The purpose of the District is to provide water, sewer, drainage or flood control facilities and services. The cost of District facilities is not included in the purchase price of your property.
