BEGINNING at a ½ inch iron rod set for the north corner of this tract on the southwest right of way of a 20 Ft. wide non-exclusive easement for "private road, access, maintenance, utilities and public service vehicles" described as Tract No. 7 in instrument recorded in Clerk's File No. 2005009082 of said official records and being located S 76º 53' 53" E 1316.12 Ft. from a ¾ inch iron rod found at the northwest corner of said 164.0628 acre tract:

THENCE: S 21º 05' W on a line within said 164.0628 acres, at 4.79 Ft. pass a ½ inch iron rod set for reference corner, at 145.90 Ft. pass a ½ inch iron rod set for reference corner, in all 208.64 to a point in Sycamore Lake for the south corner of this tract;

THENCE: N 41º 46' W 255.70 Ft. and N 14º 40' W 127.83 Ft., with said lake and within said 164.0628 acres, to a point for the west corner of this tract;

THENCE: N 46º 43' E, leaving said lake and continuing within said 164.0628 acres, at 55.19 Ft. pass a ½ inch iron rod found for reference corner, at 133.23 Ft. pass a ½ inch iron rod set for reference corner, in all 144.93 Ft. to the PLACE OF BEGINNING AND CONTAINING WITHIN THESE BOUNDS 1.353 ACRES OF LAND.
