The total amount of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes, excluding refunding bonds that are separately approved by voters, approved by the voters are:

- (i) \$39,500,000 for water and sewer facilities;
- (ii) \$0 for road facilities; and
- (iii) \$0 for parks and recreational facilities.

The aggregate initial principal amounts of all such bonds issued are:
