

License Holder Disclosure

Notice to: All buyers and Buyer Agents
Texas law requires a real estate license holder who is a party to a transaction or acting on
behalf of a spouse, parent, child, business entity in which the license holder owns more
than 10%, or a trust for which the license holder acts as trustee or of which the license
holder or the license holder's spouse, parent or child is a beneficiary, to notify the other
party in writing before entering into a contract of sale.
The Code of Ethics Article 4 and Standard of Practice 4-1 requires REALTORS® to
disclose any relationship. Standard of Practice 12-6 further requires REALTORS® to
disclose their status as owners or landlords and as REALTORS® or real estate license
holders when advertising unlisted real property for sale. Requirement also applies when
license holders intend to acquire or sell property on their own behalf.
