

CCESS STAIRWAY SHALL COMPLY WITH SECTION MI305.1.3 AS AMMENDED BY JOUSTON. THE REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN REVISED AS SUCH. NITAINING APPLIANCES REQUIRING ACCESS SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH AIRWAY WITH A CLEAR OPENING NOT LESS THAN 22-INCHES IN WIDTH HARDWARE, AND A LOAD CAPACITY OF NOT LESS THAN 350-POUNDS. AN

A CLEAR AND UNOBSTRUCTED PASSAGEWAY LARGE ENOUGH TO ALLOW HE LAGEST APPLIANCE, BUT NOT LESS THAN 30-INCHES HIGH AND 30-INCHES MORE THAN 20-FEET IN LENGTH WHEN MEASURED ALONG THE CENTERLINE ASSAGEWAY FROM THE OPENING TO THE APPLIANCE. PASSAGEWAY SHALL HAVE CONTINUOUS SOLID FLOORING IN ACCORDANCE WITH

DEEP AND 30-INCHES WIDE SHALL HAVE CONTINUED SOLID FLOORING IN ACCORDANCE WITH DEEP AND 30-INCHES WIDE SHALL BE PRESENT ALONG ALL SIDES OF THE APPLIANCE WHERE 2210821-80-INCHES WIDE SHALL BE PRESENT ALONG ALL SIDES OF THE APPLIANCE WHERE 22108221-80-INCHES WHERE SUCH DIMENSIONS ARE LARGE ENOUGH TO ALLOW REMOVAL
