Tenant Selection Criteria

- 1. Tenants must make at least 3x the rental rate.
- 2. No evictions or eviction filings within the last 5 years.
- 3. Credit score of at least 625. If credit score is below 625 landlord may deny the application or ask for additional deposit.
- 4. Can't owe previous landlords or utility bills
- 5. No felony or domestic violence convictions within the last 10 years.
- 6. No sex offenders. (Automatic Denial)
