

METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTION of a 19.92 Acre Tract George J. Wilson Survey, A-490 & S.L. Wilson Survey, A-493 Grimes County, Texas July 15, 2014

All that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being situated in Grimes County, Texas, out of the George J. Wilson Survey, Abstract No. 490, the S.L. Wilson Survey, Abstract No. 493, being a part of Second tract, called 78 acres, as described in a Deed from Gordon Mims, et ux, to Puzzolanic Materials Corporation, dated December 28, 1938, of record in Volume 146, Page 345 of the Real Property Records of Grimes County, Texas, being a part of a called "South ½" of the 160 acre tract as described in a Deed from Gordon H. Mims, et ux, to Puzzolanic Materials Corporation, dated December 1, 1938, of record in Volume 145, Page 581 of the Real Property Records of Grimes County, Texas, a part of a called 160 acre tract as described in a Deed from Mrs. J.W. Smith, et al to Will D. Smith, dated October 27, 1942, of record in Volume 160, page 415 of the Real Property Records of Grimes County, Texas, all of a called 1.65 acre tract as described in a Warranty Deed from Will D. Smith Co., Inc. to Kitty M. Markham, dated July, 21, 2010, of record in Volume 1347, Page 770 of the Real Property Records of Grimes County, Texas and more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a set $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron rod, in a barbed wire fence line, for the Northeast corner of the tract of land herein described, the Southeast corner of a called 140.982 acre tract as described in a Deed to Will D. Smith, et al (645/115), lying within the interior of the called 78 acre tract mentioned above and in the Southwest ROW of the Chicago Rock Island & Pacific Railroad (100 ft. ROW at this point) (59/628 & 714/633);

THENCE S 39°05'31" E, 1,688.85 ft., along the Southwest ROW of said Railroad and a Northeast line of the tract of land herein described to a set $\frac{1}{2}$ inch iron rod, 54.2 ft. Northwest of a x-tie fence corner post, for its Easterly Southeast corner, in the apparent South line of the called "South $\frac{1}{2}$ " of the 160 acre tract mentioned above, in the apparent North line of a called 19.25 acre tract, more or less, as described in a Deed to Alan Maurice Stallones (732/294 & 140/586) and in the apparent South line of the George J. Wilson Survey, A-490;

THENCE S 87°21'52" W, 1,068.42 ft., along the apparent North line of said 19.25 acre Stallones tract (732/294), the apparent South line of the called "South ½" of the 160 acre tract mentioned above and the apparent South line of the George J. Wilson Survey to a set ½ inch iron rod, 11.5 ft. West of a x-tie fence corner post, for its apparent Southwest corner, the apparent Southwest corner of said "South ½" of 160 acre tract, the apparent Northwest corner of said 19.25 acre Stallones tract , in the East line the called 160 acre tract men mentioned above, in the East line of the S.L. Wilson Survey, A-495, in the apparent centerline of a called 60 ft. wide abandoned Roadway (166/348) and same being in an East line of the called 1.65 acre tract mentioned above, from which a found ½ inch iron rod for the Northeast corner of said 1.65 acre tract brs. N $02^{\circ}53'42''$ W, 29.90 ft.;
