Refuse, Yard Waste, & Bulk Items Pickup Specification Sheet

Residential Recycling & Refuse of Texas is honored to have you as a new customer effective January 01, 2016. Our main goal is customer service and doing the task right. If we ever fall short of your expectations, please give our office a call at 1-346-248-5222 and let us know. We will work harder to ensure your satisfaction.

1. Refuse (household garbage) collection days are **Monday and Thursday**.
2. Customers (residents) must place refuse items out by 7:00am on collection days.
3. Residents will provide their own refuse containers (garbage cans).
4. Up to six (6) containers of properly contained refuse, each weighing less than 40 pounds will be accepted for weekly pickup.
5. Trash will be collected up at the resident's garage door or equal.
6. Yard waste will be collected at the curb and must be placed in sturdy plastic bags weighing no more than 40 pounds.
7. All branches and tree trimmings shall be no more than 3 inches in diameter and no longer than four (4) feet in length. Bundles must be securely tied and weigh less than 40 pounds.
8. Bulk items will be picked up at the curb once a week on Thursday. There is a limit of one bulk item per household per week.
9. Excluded items: It is illegal to transport any hazardous waste in a trash truck and dispose of it in a landfill.

Hazardous waste includes:

Medical waste	Toxic or radioactive waste
Any appliance containing Freon	Paint
Acids	Petroleum products or filters
Car batteries	Chemicals of any kind
Car parts	Construction trash (<i>including concrete, large quantities of carpeting, fencing, rolls of carpet or any construction type material.</i>)
Car Tires	Dead animals
Car tires	

Other excluded items include:

- Large pieces of glass (*must be broken down in smaller pieces and placed in a closed box*)
 - Large sofas and sleepers
 - Furniture with metal frames and other metal items
 - Improperly contained animal waste (*must be placed in sealed or tied bags to be included in collection*)
10. Any CFC (Freon) item must be properly tagged and certified, by the resident requesting pickup, that all Freon has been properly removed in accordance with the Federal Clean Air Act regulations. If items are not tagged, they will be left at the curb.
 11. Bulk items which are too large for the contractor to put in with the normal weekly pickup may be collected separately upon request. The resident requesting service will be billed separately at a negotiated price depending on size, quantity and handling required to remove and dispose of item(s).
 12. Holidays observed: Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If the holiday falls on a scheduled pickup day, service will resume the next scheduled collection day following the holiday.
 13. Effective August 01, 2022, and until further notice, Stanley Lake Municipal Utility District will charge district customers (residents) twenty-four dollars and fifty cents (\$24.50) per month for the services stated on this sheet. Collection of these charges will remain as part of the monthly water bill.
